The Council/Board is prohibited by the Open Meetings Act to engage in a discussion of any item or issue that is not posted on the Agenda. Your request or comments will be duly noted and referred to City Staff. Make sure to include your contact information, if you wanted to be contacted.

Procedure for addressing the Mayor and City Council:

- 1. The Public Comment portion of the meeting will be opened and your name will be called if you have submitted this form to the City Secretary. Please state your name and address for the record and limit your comments to three minutes.
- 2. The Council/Board expects any citizen to speak in a civil manner, with due respect for the decorum of the meeting, and with due respect for all persons attending. The Public Comment section of the agenda is not provided as a platform for a member of the public to use profane, insulting, or threatening language directed toward the Council, the City staff, and/or any person in the Council's presence and/or racial, ethnic, or gender will not be tolerated. Violation of these rules may result in the following sanctions:
 - a. Cancellation of a speaker's remaining time;
 - b. Removal from the Council Chambers;
 - c. A contempt citation; and/or
 - d. Such other civil and/or criminal sanctions may be authorized under the constitution, statutes, and codes of the State of Texas.
