CANDIDATE ELIGIBILTY REQUIREMENTS	DEADLINE TO FILE CANDIDATE APPLICATION	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Shall be a citizen of the United States of America; 2. Shall be 18 years of age or older; 3. Have not been determined by a final judgment of a court exercising probatejurisdiction to be: (A) totally mentally incapacitated; or (B) partially mentallyincapacitated without the right to vote; 4. Have not been finally convicted of a felony from which the person has notbeen pardoned or otherwise released from the resulting disabilities; 5. Have resided continuously within the state of Texas for a period of at leasttwelve (12) months and within the corporate limits of the City of Dayton,continuously for a period of at least six (6) months immediately preceding theelection; 6. Be registered to vote in the territory from which the office is elected; 7. Shall not have a delinquent indebtedness to the City of Dayton; 8. If the mayor or other members of the council shall fail to maintain the foregoing qualifications, without acceptable valid excuse, or shall be absent from three (3) consecutive meetings without valid excuse, the council may, at its next regular meeting, declare a vacancy to exist and shall fill the vacancy as set forth in the City Charter; 9.
